**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY COURT SHOULD NOT GRANT PLAINTIFFS'
MOTION FOR DEFAULT FINAL JUDGEMENT**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiffs' Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(b) Motion for Default Judgment [DE 40], filed April 28, 2026. The Court has carefully considered the Motion and the record, and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.


Plaintiffs filed a Complaint on January 7, 2026 [DE 1]. Defendants were served on January 14, 2026, making the deadline to respond February 4, 2026. [DE 35]. As of the date of this Order, Defendants have not yet responded to the operative complaint. On April 14, 2026, Plaintiffs obtained a Clerk's Entry of Default against Defendants. *See* [DE 38]. Thereafter, on April 28, 2026, Plaintiffs filed the instant Motion [DE 40] seeking a default judgment against Defendants.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. On or before **May 12, 2026**, Defendants Does 1-7 shall respond to this Order to Show Cause, showing why this Motion [DE 40] should not be granted.

2. Failure to respond shall result in the Court granting Plaintiffs' Motion [DE 40] and entering judgment against Defendants Does 1-7.
3. Plaintiffs shall serve a copy of this Order to Show Cause on Defendants Does 1-7 and file a Notice of Compliance in the record stating the date and manner upon which they have done so.
